- Rest voice for 24 hours
- Drink plenty of fluids over the next few days
- Increase your diet starting with soft foods and then as tolerated
- Take medications as prescribed
- See your physician as scheduled following your procedure:

POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS:

- You may feel drowsy and nauseated from the anesthesia
- It is normal to experience a low-grade fever (100.0° to 101.5°)
- It is normal to experience some throat pain possibly lasting up to one week

- If there is any sign of bleeding
- If you have a fever greater than 101.5°
- If you have a low fever that lasts for more than three days
- If you have any questions or concerns
